

Fee Schedule 2022

School Fees at Grace Primary include all compulsory activities where a whole class or the whole school is involved. This means that families can have peace of mind that they will not receive additional fees and charges throughout the year while students are participating in compulsory activities (including camps, excursions and student book packs).

Enrolment Fees

Enrolment Application Fee

A non-refundable Enrolment Application Fee of \$100 applies per application charged at the time of submission.

Enrolment Confirmation Bond

An Enrolment Confirmation Bond per child is required to secure each enrolment. This Bond is refundable based on the conditions detailed in our Fee Policy, which includes the request that a full term's notice is given for withdrawal of a student or a term's fees will be required. This fee is set at \$800 per child.

Annual Fee Structure

Tuition Fee

A compulsory Tuition Fee of \$4,750 per student per year applies. This fee covers all costs associated with the delivery of compulsory curriculum and associated learning activities.

Facilities Levy

A compulsory Facilities Levy of \$650 per family per year applies. This levy is to provide a secure source of funds for maintaining school facilities and contributing to building new facilities.

Resource and Activity Levy

A compulsory Resource and Activity Levy of \$800 per student per year applies. This levy covers all resources and activities that support and enrich the delivery of the curriculum. This levy ensures that families have no other compulsory expenses and covers:

- School camps (Year 1 to 5) & Canberra Trip (Year 6)
- Subject costs, including all books and stationery (*students to provide pencil case and headphones*)
- All class excursions (including bus travel)
- Access to iPads & school provided apps (Prep to Year 3)
- Support for BYOD iPad program including school provided apps (Year 4 to 6)
- All class special guests and performances
- Access to a range of other digital technologies
- License for Matific (Mathematics online subscription)
- License for Seesaw (digital portfolio and communication tool)
- Yearbook
- Strings Program (Year 2)
- Full Instrumental Immersion Program with group lessons and ensemble/band (Year 3)
- Student insurance
- Sport, including Interschool Sport (Year 4 to 6)

Discounts

Sibling Discounts

Families who have more than one student at Grace Primary will receive discounts based on the Tuition Fee as follows:

- Second child – Save 5% (a discount of \$237.50)
- Third child – Save 25% (a discount of \$1,187.50)
- Fourth+ child – Save 100% (a discount of \$4,750.00)

Annual Payment Discount

Families can save a further 3% of the Tuition Fee (\$142.50) when the annual amount is paid in full by Week 1 in Term 1.

Family Loyalty Discount

Families who have students enrolled at Grace Primary and Grace College will receive a discount of \$250 for the eldest child on their Grace Primary Fees, and a further \$750 discount on their Grace College fees. A form will be provided on enrolment or is available from either school.

Summary of Fees, Charges and Discounts

The table below is designed to assist your family to calculate your total fees for the year. To use this table write the amount (column A) for each child you have enrolled in the grey shaded box (column B), then add up all amounts in column B to calculate your total family fees (T). This table has the sibling discount already calculated for you. Further discounts will apply if you pay annually or are eligible for the Family Loyalty Discount (see above).

Payment of Fees and Due Dates

Statements are issued prior to the beginning of the school year. Fees can be paid in one of three ways:

1. Annually by Week 1 of Term 1
2. Each term before the end of Week 1 (four equal payments, refer dates below)
3. Direct debit (a school controlled weekly, fortnightly or monthly payment that commences before the end of Week 1, Term 1 and results in all fees paid before the end of the school year)
